40.00 Chains

Set a stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ S. corner, 12 x 12 x 6, 8 inches in the ground on summit of Umpqua divide, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face.

From which:

- A larch, 24-inch diameter bears S16°W, 15 links, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.
- A larch, 36-inch diameter bears N22°W, 10 links, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT

Surveyed by P. Applegate August 31, 1891.

RETRACEMENTS

From the corner of Sections 3, 4, 33 and 34. West, between Sections 4 and 33.

40.20 Fall 60 links S. of $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner.

80.41 Fall 133 links S. of corner of Sections 4, 5, 32, and 33.

A point 40.00 chains in departure from the corner of Sections 33 and 34 only, previously described.

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground, **for ¼ Section corner of Section 33 only**, with brass cap marked:

¼ S 33

From which

- A white fir, 25-inch diameter bears N25°E, 47 links distance. Marked: ¼S 33 BT.
- A white fir, 35-inch diameter bears N55°. , 84 links distance. Marked: ¼S 33 BT.

The original ¼ Section corner of Section 4 and 33, which is a sandstone, 12x10x5-inch firmly set, marked ¼ on N. face.

Quarter corner common to Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 2 East, W.M. $V = 19\frac{1}{2}^\circ$

Found projecting 9 inches (23 cm), the 1-inch (2.5 cm) diameter iron pipe with GLO brass cap marked:

$\frac{1}{4}S33$

As recorded by L. Carter in 1937.

Bearing trees recorded by Carter found as follows:

- Sawed Shasta red fir stump, 30-inch (76 cm) diameter bears N25E, 30.05 feet (9.16 m) to center. Record: N25E, 31.02 feet (9.45 m).
- Shasta red fir, 37-inch (94 cm) diameter, with healed single blaze bears Record: N55W, 55.44 feet (16.90 m) to center.

I marked a new tree CS-BT:

- Hemlock, 6-inch (15 cm) diameter bears N40E, 13.10 feet (3.99 m) to center of tree at lower blaze.
