Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner, with brass cap marked

$\frac{1}{4}$
S33 | S34

From which:

- A white pine, 23-inch diameter bears N.37°E., 87 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 BT.
- A white pine, 28-inch diameter bears N.52°W., 45 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 BT.
