Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner, with brass cap marked:

S 27
 $\frac{1}{4}$ S —
S 34
1937

From which:

- A cedar, 13-inch diameter bears N.26 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 26 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 BT.
- A fir, 35-inch diameter bears S.76 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 26 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 BT.
