### 38.39 Chains

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner, with brass cap marked:

$$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ S34 \mid S35 \\ 1937 \end{array}$$

From which:

- A fir, 8-inch diameter bears S.64°E., 39 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 35 BT.
- A fir, 8-inch diameter bears N.46°W., 13 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 34 BT.
