40.00 Chains

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 14 inches in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner, with brass cap marked:

S 26  
 $\frac{1}{4}$ S —  
S 35  
1937

From which:

- A cedar, 38-inch diameter bears N.5°E., 8 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 26 BT.
- A fir, 12-inch diameter bears S.32°E., 12 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 35 BT.
