39.40 Chains

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner, with brass cap marked:

$$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ S35 \mid S36 \\ 1937 \end{array}$$

From which:

- A fir, 45-inch diameter bears S.48°E., 100 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 BT.
- A fir, 40-inch diameter bears S.60°W., 46 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 BT.
