40 Chains

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 27 inches in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner, with brass cap marked:

$$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ \text{S26} \mid \text{S25} \\ 1937 \end{array}$$

From which:

- A fir, 10-inch diameter bears N.72°E., 48 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 BT.
- A fir, 10-inch diameter bears S.48°W., 18 links distance. Marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 BT.
