### 40.00 Chains

Set an iron-stone, 24x20x10-inch 16 inches in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face.

From which:

- A pine, 40-inch diameter bears N.54°E, 89 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 BT.
- A pine, 45-inch diameter bears N.2°W., 109 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 BT.

## RESURVEY

### 40.00 Chains

Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1-inch diameter, 28 inches in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  **Section corner of Section 36 only**, with brass cap marked:

S36 |  
1928

From which:

- A chinquapin, 4-inch diameter bears S.73°W., 31 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 BT.
- A pine, 54-inch diameter bears N.72°W., 9 links distance. Marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 BT.
