

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 300340

Quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 21, Township 32 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found original stone 18x8x8-inch with  $\frac{1}{4}$  scribed on the westerly face lying on its easterly face.

At base of said stone set an iron pipe 1-inch in diameter, 36 inches long 34 inches in the ground with bronze disc marked:

JACKSON COUNTY  
T32S R1W  
20 | 21  
1984

From which:

- Evidence of original bearing tree; stump hole bears N32°W, 2.64 feet (There is indication, in this general area, that there was a heavy forest fire near the turn of the century).

New references:

- Douglas Fir, 7-inch diameter bears N44°06'E, 27.93 feet (8.51 m) scribed "CS" "BT".
- Douglas Fir, 15-inch diameter bears S32°40'E, 49.50 feet (15.08 m) scribed "CS" "BT".
- The original stone was placed alongside of pipe with rock mound built alongside of monument.

This corner falls on slight easterly slope in a clear-cut about 10 years old and about 45 feet West of a new North and South line.
