

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340400

Quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 21, Township 32 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found the single remaining original bearing tree, a Douglas Fir, 39-inch diameter, containing scribed "BT" in opened lower face, as recorded by R. S. Moore, in 1883.

From the proceeding original evidence: Set a 1x36-inch galvanized iron pipe, 27 inches in the ground with a 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

From which:

- The above-described original bearing tree bears Record: S25°W, 6.6 feet to scribed face. Re-measured 6.93 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Marked new tree "CS" "BT":

- Douglas Fir, 9-inch diameter bears N31°W, 25.05 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on 50% East slope and about 140 feet East of a spur that slopes S30°E.
