

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600140

Quarter corner common to Sections 35 and 36, Township 32 South, Range 1 West.

Found the basalt stone monument marked "¼" on West face, as described in the official record.

From said stone, the original bearing tree (now a 30" Maple) scribed "¼s" bears South 58° West, 3.96 feet. (Record S53°W), and the stump of the original Fir bearing tree scribed "¼s" bears North 18° East, 25.08 feet.

Replaced the stone with a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 34" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T32S, R1W  
¼ cor. 35 | 36 c.s.  
1961

And set the stone alongside.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- A 22" White Fir scribed "CS-BT" bears North 88° West, 35.9 feet;
- A 12" Yew scribed "CS-BT" bears South 38° East, 68.2 feet.

Corner falls about 25' West from the center of the West branch of Elk Creek.

## SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600140

Quarter corner common to Sections 35 and 36, Township 32 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found projecting 6 inches, the 1-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe, with 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:

T32S R1W  
¼ 35|36  
Cor. 1961 C.S.

Alongside, marked "¼.s"

An original bearing tree recorded by R. Moore in 1883 and reported on First Re-establishment,

- Now a beaver-gnawed maple stump; hollow and tipped southerly bears S58°W, 4.5 feet to center near base. Record (1961): 3.96 feet.

The single remaining bearing tree marked in 1961,

- Now a 24-inch diameter fir snag, with healed blazes bears Record: N88°W, 35.9 feet to estimated face; 36.8 feet to center of tree.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Alder, 15-inch diameter bears S8°E, 36.6 feet.
- Alder, 8-inch diameter bears S43°W, 27.60 feet.

Corner lies 16.5 feet East of middle of creek, C. S35°W, about 40 feet West of top of steep bank along west edge of opening at a point, an estimated 120 feet North of stream c. West located near the (visual) P.I. of road c. South and East.
