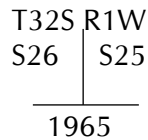


FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600240

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 26, Township 32 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found flush, encompassed by large tipped over trees, a 3¼-inch diameter standard BLM brass cap marked:



Original bearing trees are now gone. The 13x10x8-inch original stone, marked "¼" is found along East side of corner.

Bearing trees marked by the BLM in 1965 found:

- White Fir, 18-inch diameter with healed single blaze bears S24°E, 12.24 feet to center of tree at base. Record: 12.54 feet.
- The center of the stump of a broken off down fir, 9-inch diameter, containing scribe marks in partly exposed face bear S70°W, 24.54 feet. Record: 24.42 feet.

Marked a new tree "CS" "BT":

Douglas Fir, 18-inch diameter bears S84½°W, 55.76 feet.

An aluminum nail set in center of 63-inch diameter sawed fir stump bears N60°W, 9.90 feet.

Corner lies on West (35%) slope, an estimated 150 feet East of old logging road c. North-South.
