

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640100

Quarter corner common to Section 1, Township 33 South, Range 1 West and Section 36, Township 32 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

At the corner, found projecting 14 inches, the 1-inch diameter iron pipe with 2½-inch diameter standard GLO brass cap marked:

S36
¼S —
S1
1917

The single remaining bearing tree marked in 1917, a Douglas Fir, now 25-inch diameter with healed single blaze bears S40°E, 97.0 feet to center. Record: 96.36 feet.

Marked new trees "CS" "BT" and took measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- Douglas Fir, 6-inch diameter bears N38°E, 62.67 feet
- Black Oak, 6-inch diameter bears S11°W, 8.25 feet.

Corner lies about S18°W, 75 feet from location marker on 30-inch diameter Fir stump located at top of ridge alongside road.
