

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100200

Section corner on the Range Line to Sections 25 and 36, Township 32 South, Range 3 East and Sections 30 and 31, Township 32 South, Range 4 East.

Found an 18" White Fir to the N.E. plainly scribed "S-30", when the tree was about 12" in diameter (said BT being reported as a 3" Fir in the original Government notes.) Also found remains of the Chinquapin BT to the S.W.

From said evidence:

- Set a 8"x14"x20" basalt stone with "X" on top, 12" in the ground for corner.

From which:

- The original BT, now an 18" White Fir bears N55°E, 5.3 feet.
- A 16" White Fir, scribed "CS-BT" bears N21°W, 35.4 feet;
- A 15" Cedar, scribed "CS-BT" bears S29°W, 34.6 feet;
- A 22" White Fir, scribed "CS-BT" bears S74°E, 42.8 feet;
