

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200300

Section corner to Sections 19, 20, 29, & 30, Township 32 South, Range 4 East.

Found the 14"x12"x8" basalt stone with five notches on the face; the original N.W. BT with scribe legible; the stump of the SW. BT and the remains of the stump to the S.E.

From this evidence set a 2"x22" iron pipe 20" in the ground for corner.

From which:

- The original BT, now a 14" Cedar with upper scribe intact bears N.40°W., 30.4 feet;
- A 14" Douglas Fir, scribed "C.S.-BT" bears N. 52° E., 13.7 feet;
- A 7" Fir, scribed "C.S.-BT" bears S. 57° E., 10.8 feet;
- A 14" Cedar, scribed "C.S.-BT" bears S. 30° W., 34.8 feet.
