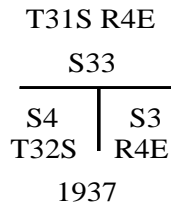


**FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT  
CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 3 AND 4 ONLY  
GCDB 400700**

Section Corner common to Sections 3 and 4 only, Township 32 South Range 4 East, W.M.

Found the 2-inch diameter iron pipe with 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:



Protruding 6 inches aboveground in a small mound of stone as set by the General Land Office in 1937.

From which, bearing tree marked by the GLO found;

- White Fir 27-inch diameter, with healed single blaze and snow blaze bears S08°W, 134.30 feet to center of tree at base. Record distance 134.64 feet.

Marked a new tree 'CS BT' and measured to the center at base.

- Hemlock 11-inch diameter bears S46°E, 11.97 feet.

Corner lies on a Southwest slope and approximately 200 feet North of the Northerly edge of meadow.
