

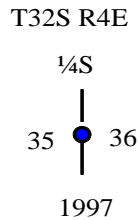
## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600140

Quarter Corner common to Sections 35 and 36, Township 32 South Range 4 East , W.M.

Found stone 16x12x8-inch protruding 8 inches aboveground with '1/4' marked on the West face, set by Rufus Moore in 1884.

Remove stone and set a 1x30-inch Galvanized iron pipe with attached Jackson County Surveyor 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:



Protruding 6 inches above large mound stone with original stone alongside.

A mound of stone called for by Moore, 3 feet x 3 feet x 2 feet high bears West, 5 feet.

Marked trees 'CS BT' and measured to center of tree at base.

- White Fir 12-inch diameter bears N43°E, 24.02 feet.
- White Fir 14-inch diameter bears S15½°E, 3.25 feet.
- White Fir 13-inch diameter bears S69°W, 45.90 feet.
- White Fir 8-inch diameter bears N05°W, 49.43 feet.

Corner lies on a Southwest slope in open timber.
