

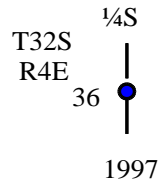
FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700140

Quarter Corner to Section 36, Township 32 South Range 4 East, W.M.

Found stone 16x12x10-inch protruding 12 inches aboveground with '1/4' marked on the West face, set by Rufus Moore in 1884.

Removed stone and set a 1x30-inch Galvanized iron pipe 6 inches in the ground to bedrock with attached Jackson County Surveyor 2½-inch diameter brass cap marked:



Protruding 4 inches above large mound stone with original stone alongside.

A mound of stone called for by Moore, 3 feet x3ft.x2feet high bears West, 5 feet.

Mark trees 'CS BT' and measure to center of tree at base.

- White Pine 13-inch diameter bears N08°E, 32.04 feet.
- Red Fir 17-inch diameter bears S21½°E, 14.45 feet.
- Red Fir 15-inch diameter bears S42°W, 21.33 feet.
- Red Fir 19-inch diameter bears N85°W, 10.57 feet.

Corner lies on a West slope approximately 200 feet North of trail.
