One-Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, Township, 32 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

- 42-inch Douglas Fir, now snag, N9°W, 35.0 feet, burnt face, faint scribe marks visible.
- No trace of Southeast BT due to old logging.
