

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100140

Quarter corner common to Section 36 Township 34 South, Range 2 West, and Section 31, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Found, the single remaining bearing tree recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, a white oak, now 24-inch diameter with axed and/or rotted out faces.

From the preceding evidence, I set a 1x36-inch G.I. pipe flush with the surface of the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Jackson County 1978  
T34S  
¼S  
36 | 31  
R2W R1W

From which:

- The above-described original bearing tree bears Record: N32°E, 5.28 feet to estimated face.

I mark new trees CS BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White oak, 15-inch diameter, bears N55¾°E, 71.88 feet.
- South fork 10-inch diameter, of a double white oak bears N36°W, 34.81 feet

Corner lies 40 feet North of top of small ridge c. E-W.
