

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100500

Corner on township line to Sections 7 and 18, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, and Sections 12 and 13, Township 34 South, Range 2 West W.M.

Found original BT to SE plainly scribed; also, remains of BT to NW and NE. Mr. Houston identified the BT to NE, no scribes visible.

Set 2"x 36" galvanized pipe, 28" in the ground in the bottom of a small draw, for corner.

From which:

- A 6" cedar scribed C.S.-BT bears S.22°E., 13.9 feet.
- A 14" cedar scribed C.S.-BT bears N.7°W., 30.8 feet.
- A 36" white oak scribed C.S.-BT bears N.37°30'E., 95.8 feet.
- A 12" cedar scribed C.S.-BT bears S. 67°30'W., 39.3 feet.
