

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240600

Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 34 South, Range 1 West W.M.

Set a 1"x 36" galvanized iron pipe with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T34S R1W
5
¼S — Cor.
8
C.S.
1972

34" in the ground for corner.

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 12" Black Oak, plainly scribed) bears N51°W, 19.8 feet;
- The original bearing tree (now a stump hole with Black Oak remains) bears S68°E, 36.6 feet to the center.

Mark new trees as follows:

- Scribed a 6" Black Oak, "CS-BT" which bears N14¾°W, 21.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- Scribed a 5" White Oak, "CS-BT" which bears S74½°E, 16.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
