

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 440100

Quarter corner common to Section 34, Township 34 South and Section 3, Township 35 South,
Range 1 West, W.M. $V = 19\frac{1}{2}^\circ$

Set a 1x36-inch G.I. pipe 28 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

T34S R1W

T35S
Jackson County 1974

- Set at record bearing and distance from original 1854 Ives and Hyde BT to the S.E., now a 26 ins. White Oak, bears S33°E, 50.82 feet.
- Also found fragmented pieces of Yellow Pine scattered on surface of ground.
- At record location of original N.W. BT, corner falls approximately 1 foot South of corner post where East-West fence line joins a North-South fence line, said post being terminus of North-South fence line.

I scribe a new tree C.S. BT:

- The Southerly fork of a 8 ins. White Oak, bears S69°W, 64.7 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Hammel Lateral bears West 154 feet.
