

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 440200

Quarter corner common to Sections 27 and 34, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M. $V = 20^\circ$

Set a 1x36-inch G.I. pipe 28 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze cap marked:

T34S R1W

¼S —
34
Jackson County 1974

In a mound of stone.

From which:

- The 10 ins. Pine marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854, now a stump broken above the legible BT scribe, with the snag top bent over and still attached, bears record $S40^\circ W$, 25.74 feet.
- No existing Black Oak at record $N75^\circ E$, 21.78 feet. However, Black Oak fragments were found in the vicinity.

New trees marked C.S. BT with measurements taken to center of tree at lower blaze:

- A White Oak, 6½-inch diameter, bears $N34^\circ W$, 40.75 feet.
- A White Oak, 8-inch diameter, bears $S9\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 50.65 feet.

An East-West fence bears South 11 feet. Summit of Vestal Butte bears $S70^\circ E$.
