

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500400

Corner to Sections 14, 15, 22 & 23, Township 34 South, Range 1 West.

Found mound of stone for corner and all 4 original witness trees.

Set a 1"x 36" galvanized iron pipe 20" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T34S R1W
Sec
15 | 14
----- CS
22 | 23
Cor.
1960

For corner and raised a mound of stone around said pipe corner.

From which:

- The original witness tree (now a 6" W oak snag) plainly scribed bears 17°E, 89.5 feet;
- The original witness tree (now an 18" White Oak) with large scar healed bears N7°W, 19.5 feet to the face;
- The original witness tree (now a 22" W oak) with large scar healed bears S53°E, 14.1 feet to the face;
- The original witness tree (now a 20" W oak intact) bears S66°W, 45.2 feet to the face.

I mark new trees as follows:

- A 4" W oak scribed CS-BT bears N53°E, 29.6 feet.
