

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500540

Quarter corner common to Section 10 and 11, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M. $V = 21^\circ$

From the following evidence, at the location described below, I set a 1x36-inch G.I. pipe 30 ins. in the ground with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. bronze disc marked:

- An original bearing tree, a white oak, now 16-inch diameter scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$ " in partially opened upper face, bears Record: $N62^\circ W$, 20.46 feet, to scribed face.
- Burned and rotted black oak remains at location of recorded original line tree.

From which I mark new trees CS BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- White oak, 8-inch diameter, bears $S84^\circ E$, 45.35 feet.
- White oak, 10-inch diameter, bears $S57^\circ W$, 49.96 feet.

Corner lies on steep South slope about 230 feet South of spur, c. NE.
