

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600540

Quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 12, T34S, R1W, W.M.

Set a 1"x36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T. 34 S. R. 1 W.
¼ 11 | 12 Cor.
C.S.
1970

For corner.

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 9" White Oak, plainly scribed) bears N53°E, 33.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- The original bearing tree (now a 17" White Oak snag, with scribe marks visible) bears S5¾°W, 12.5 feet to the face of the lower blaze (Record: 12" White Oak, S15°W, 12.5 feet). Mark new trees as follows:
- A 9" Yellow Pine scribed "CS-BT" bears N48½°E, 79.6 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
- A 12" Yellow Pine scribed "CS-BT" bears N56¾°W, 39.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
