

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100340

Quarter corner common to Sections 24, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, and Section 19, Township 34 South, Range 2 East, W.M. $V = 18^\circ$

Found original N.E. BT, a Yellow Pine, now 42-inch diameter, with scribing visible in opened face (Record = $N27^\circ E$, 9.24 feet.) and the original S.W. BT, a Fir, now 24-inch diameter, with healed blazes (Record = $S13^\circ W$, 42.9 feet.)

At record bearing and distance from each of the above I set a 1 ins. x 36-inch G.I. pipe, 30 ins. in the ground, with a 2½-inch bronze disc marked:

C.S.
1973

I marked: a new tree, C.S. BT:

- A Cedar, 17-inch diameter, bears $S58^\circ E$, 46.1 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
