

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200400

Corner to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, Township 34 South, Range 2 East.

Found original white oak BT to Northeast with scribe visible; together with the evidence of the other BTs but no scribe visible.

Set 2"x 36" galvanized pipe for corner 28" in the ground

From which:

- An 18" white oak scribed C.S. BT bears  $N25^{\circ}15'E$ , 57.5 feet.
- An 8" white oak scribed C.S. BT bears  $N30^{\circ}W$ , 88.8 feet.
- A 20" white oak scribed C.S. BT bears  $S75^{\circ}30'W$ , 88.1 feet.
- A 16" black oak scribed C.S. BT bears  $S55^{\circ}45'E$ , 174.8 feet.
