

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240500

Quarter corner 8 and 17, Township 34 South, Range 2 East.

Found stake to mark corner; also original BT to Northwest intact the scribe legible. Also a dead white oak tree to Southeast which checks government record.

Set 1" x 36" galvanized pipe for corner.

From which:

- The original BT, a 16" black oak bears N.22°W., 65.34 feet scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. BT with 70 growth ring over the scribe.
- Scribe a 30" fir C.S.-BT which bears S.80°45'E., 7.5 feet.
