

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

### GCDB 300700

Section corner common to Sections 32 and 33, Township 33 South, and Sections 4 and 5, Township 34 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 4 inches, the 2½-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe with a 3½-inch diameter brass cap set by the BLM in 1965, marked:

Bearing trees recorded on Survey No. 2004 in 1962, found with healed blazes and measured to center of trees at base:

- Madrone, now 17-inch diameter bears N38°E, 4.5 feet. Record; 4.0 feet.
- Madrone, now 21-inch diameter bears S75°W, 5.2 feet. Record; 4.6 feet.
- Douglas Fir, now 23-inch diameter bears N24°W, 16.3 feet. Record; 15.8 feet.

Bearing trees recorded by the BLM in 1965 found high-stumped with healed single blazes:

- White Fir bears N12°E, 25.4 feet. Record; 24.4 feet.
- Douglas Fir bears N67°W, 34.3 feet. Record; 33.7 feet.

Mark new bearing tree "CS" "BT" and take measurement to center of tree at lower blaze:

- White Fir 10-inch diameter bears S68°W, 9.5 feet.

Corner lies approx. 200 feet west of logging road.
