

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600200

Closing corner common to Sections 25, 26 and 35, Township 34 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Found at the corner position, exposed 4 ins., the 2½-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe with a 3½-inch diameter brass cap set by the BLM in 1974, marked:

T34S R2E  
S26 | S25  
——— CC  
S35

Bearing trees recorded by Eugene Henry of the GLO in 1908 found with healed blazes and measured to center of trees at base:

- Sawed cedar stump bears Record: N48½°E, 42.9 feet.
- Douglas Fir, now 49-inch diameter bears Record: N13½°W, 8.6 feet.

Mark new bearing tree "CS" "BT" and take measurement to center of tree at lower blaze:

- Douglas Fir 12-inch diameter bears N40°E, 13.9 feet.

Corner lies approximately 30 feet east of logging spur road.
