

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700200

Section corner common to Sections 25 and 36, Township 34 South, Range 2 East, and Section 31 Township 34 South, Range 3 East, W.M.

Found at corner position exposed 12 inches in a mound of stones the 2½-inch diameter galvanized iron pipe with a 3½-inch diameter brass cap set by the BLM in 1957 and marked:

T34S
R2E R3E
S25 |
— | S31
S36 |

Original bearing trees recorded by Eugene Henry of the GLO in 1908 found with single healed blazes and measured to center at base:

- Fir sawed stump bears N59°W, 6.6 feet. Record: N66°W.
- Oak root wad bears Record: S23¾°W, 38.9 feet.

Marked new bearing tree with "CS" and "BT" and took measurements to center at lower blaze:

- White Fir 8-inch diameter bears N10½°W, 28.3 feet.
- Douglas Fir 8-inch diameter bears S58½°W, 47.3 feet.

Corner lies approximately 300 feet southeasterly of gravel road.
