

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 100400

Corner common to Sections 13 and 24, Township 35 South, Range 3 West and Sections 18 and 19, Township 35 South, Range 2 West.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 29" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T35S R2 & 3W	
13	18
SEC	COR
24	19
C.S.	
1967	

From which:

- A 22" White Oak plainly scribed bears South 32½° West, 42.2 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- A 27" White Oak plainly scribed bears South 70¾° East, 26.4 feet to the face of the upper blaze.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 10" Laurel scribed CS-BT bears North 47½° West, 31.7 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 5" White Oak scribed CS-BT bears North 26½° East, 26.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

Both original trees are still alive and in good condition.
