

## FIRST RENEWAL

GCDB 200340

Quarter corner common to Sections 19 and 20, T35SR2W.

Found a ¾" iron pipe for corner. Replaced said pipe with a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with bronze cap stamped:

T35SR2W  
¼ Cor. 19 | 20 C.S.  
1962

32" in the ground for corner,

From which:

- The original witness tree (now a 36" Black Oak with portions of the old notch and "BT" scribe in negative) bears North 71° East, 32.4 feet.
- The original witness tree (now a Black Oak snag with lower overgrowth face, but no scribe) bears South 57° West 55.8 feet.

I mark new witness trees as follows:

- An 8" Laurel, scribed "CS-BT" bears North 47½° East, 39.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- A 6" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 30½° West, 39.0 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
