

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200440

Quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 18, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM $V = 19^\circ$

Found original N.W. BT marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854, a Yellow Pine, now 18 ins. diam., containing scribed "BT".

At record bearing and distance ($N43^\circ W$, 62.04 feet.) I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 15 ins. in the ground with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. bronze disc marked:

Record location of original S.E. BT falls in irrigation canal. I mound stones around corner and marked a new tree C.S. BT:

- A Yellow Pine, 11 ins. diam., bears $N17\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 31.5 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
