

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240300

Quarter Corner common to sections 20 and 29, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M. V=20

Found, at corner of South and East bearing fence lines, projecting 1 ins. the 1 ins. diam. black iron pipe set for corner on survey 1911, in 1961.

The original bearing trees recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854 are now gone, the only evidence found, being a stump-hole containing oak fragments, at record location of original Southwest Bearing Tree.

Inside found pipe, I set a yellow plastic cap marked "JACKSON C.S." and mk. the following trees "CS BT" to preserve this position:

- The westerly branch, 7 ins. diam. of a double white oak, brs. N45E, 36.30 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
- The Northwesterly branch, 6 ins. diam. of a multiple branch (4) white oak brs. S87½E, 35.50 feet to center of tree at upper blaze.

Corner lies S40½W, an estimated 120 feet from the Southwest corner of a wood frame house and about 50 feet East of transmission line course North-South.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240300

Quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 29, Township 35 South, Range 2 West. W.M.

Found a 1 ins. diam. iron pipe with yellow plastic cap marked "Jackson County" protruding 1 ins. above ground as set on the First re-establishment pg. 45 in 1979. Remove plastic cap and set a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap marked:

set in cement in the top of found pipe.

From which bearing trees marked on the First re-establishment:

- White Oak the most Westerly branch of a twin 9 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. record N45°E, 36.2 feet to center of branch at lowest point. Record distance 36.6 feet to center of tree.
- White Oak, the most Northwesterly branch of multiple stems 8 ins. diam. brs. S87°11'E, 35.8 feet to center of branch at lowest point. Record: S87½°E, 35.5 feet to center of tree at upper blaze.

Corner lies approximately 50 feet East of power-line and 15 feet South of the Southerly projection of dirt drive along power-line at old fence corner of East and South bearing fences.
