

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240600

Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 35 South, Range 2 West.

Found both original bearing trees, with scribe visible in the Southeast tree.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe driven 28" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T35S R2W

¼ cor. — c.s.
8
1965

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 28" Black Oak with scribe marks visible) bears South 19 East, 37.6 feet;
- The original bearing tree (now an 18" Black Oak) bears North 39 West, 39.6 feet.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- Scribed a 14" Fir "CS-BT" which bears South 66 West, 5.0 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- Scribed a 12" Fir "CS-BT" which bears North 63 West, 7.9 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
