

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340300

Quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 28, Township 35 South Range 2 West.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with bronze cap stamped:

T35S R2W
¼ Cor. 21 C.S.
—
28
1962

33" in the ground for corner,

From which:

- The original witness tree (now a Yellow Pine stump plainly scribed "¼ S BT") bears North $87\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ West, 114.2 feet;
- The original witness tree (now a 9" White Oak plainly scribed "BT" on a 3" core) bears South 71° East, 17.5 feet;

I mark new witness trees as follows:

- A 10" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears South $89\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East, 26.0 feet to the face of the blaze.
- An 8" White Oak, scribed "CS-BT" bears North $79\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ West, 5.5 feet to the face of the blaze.
