

## FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 340600

Quarter Corner common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T.35S., R.2W.

C.S.  
1971

32" in the ground for corner,

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 13" Black Oak snag with scribe marks visible) bears N40°W, 10.3 feet to the center of the tree;
- The original bearing tree (now an Oak stump hole) checks the Government Record within reasonable limits.

From said pipe corner, I establish new bearing trees as follows:

- Scribed a 6" White Oak, "CS-BT" which bears S49°W, 39.3 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- Scribed an 8" White Oak, "CS-BT" which bears N45¾°W, 52.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze.
