

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500400

Section Corner to 14, 15, 22 & 23, Township 35 South, Range 2 West.

Found a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 6" below the surface of the ground for corner which pipe was set by me August 1930 from the remains of the original northeast BT which BT was identified by the property owner, he being an old settler who had seen the said BT when in good condition,

From the said 2" x 36" iron pipe for corner.

- A 30" Black Oak scribed C.S. - BT bears S. $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 514.6 feet.
- A standard Jackson County benchmark tablet (a 3" bronze disk) near the westerly end of the northerly concrete head wall county bridge over Snider Creek bears N. 54° W. 383.7 feet.
- Set a 1" x 28" galvanized iron pipe which bears N 0° -40'W. 201.77 feet.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500400

Section corner common to Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

At the corner, found iron pipe 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. deep, recorded on first re-establishment, page 15, in 1946.

Inside found pipe, set G.I. pipe, 1 ins. diam., 36 ins. long, flush, with 2½ ins. diam. bronze cap marked:

JACKSON COUNTY 1980

T35S R2W

From which references noted on first re-establishment found as follows:

- A black oak, 42 ins. diam. with healed blazes, brs. S6°34'E, 514.6 feet to estimated face. Re-measured 515.85 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: S6½°E, 514.6 feet.
- Iron pipe, 1 ins. diam., found flush, brs. Record: N0°04'W, 201.77 feet

Set new references; rebars, 5/8 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, flush, with yellow plastic caps marked: "JACKSON C.S.":

- S5°34'E, 7.03 feet on north-south fence line.
- S88°47'W, 73.50 feet on north-south fence line.
- Peak of Mount McLoughlin brs. S80°31'E.

Corner lies approximately 240 feet south of Dodge Road and 0.8 feet west of north-south fence line.
