

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500500

Corner to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found ½" iron pipe to mark the corner; also original white oak BT to northwest with scribe visible.

Set a 2" x 33" iron pipe with top 6" below the surface of the road for corner at the location of the ½" pipe as found.

- Set a ⅝" x 24" iron pin which bears North 40.0 feet.
- Set a ⅝" x 24" iron pin which bears South 40.0 feet.
- Scribed a 9" white oak C.S.-BT which bears S.17°W., 61.5 feet.
- Scribed a 12" white oak C.S.-BT which bears N.62½°E., 139.0 feet.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 500500

Section corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found 14 ins. deep in monument case, the 2 ins. diam. iron pipe, set on first re-establishment, in 1944. Directly over found pipe, set a 2½ ins. diam. brass cap in concrete, flush with the road surface, marked:

An original bearing tree, recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, a White Oak, now 19 ins. diam., with exposed and rotted lower face, brs. N2°16'W, 53.55 feet to center of tree. Record: N3°W, 53.46 feet.

Bearing trees recorded in 1944 found:

- White Oak, 18 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. N62°37'E, 138.86 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record (corrected in 1960); N62½°E, 139.0 feet.
- A down and rotted oak, containing scribed "B" found at record location of Southwest bearing trees.
- An iron pin set in 1944 found projecting 1 ins., brs. N0°07'W, 40.00 feet. Record: North.
- The iron pin recorded to be South 40 feet is now gone.

Set new references:

- Chiseled cross atop the East end of a 12 ins. diam. concrete culvert, brs. S66°53'E, 31.00 feet.
- A 5/8 x 24 ins. rebar, flush, with yellow plastic cap marked "Jackson C.S.", brs. S0°07'E, 40.00 feet.

Corner lies about 3 feet South of the middle of Beagle Road and 15 feet West of the intersection of Beagle Road and private drive, C. South.
