

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 600340

Quarter section corner common to Sections 23 and 24, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found the original White Oak bearing tree to the Southeast, both blazes have been opened with part of the "BT" scribed visible.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 34" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T35S R2W
¼ 23 | 24 c.s.
cor.
1966

From which:

- The above mentioned White Oak, now 24" in diameter, bears South 27° East, 114.8 feet.

Marked the following new trees:

- A 10" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears South 53° East, 31.0 feet;
- An 8" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears North 46½° East, 14.0 feet.
