

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640200

Quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.
 $V = 20\frac{1}{2}^\circ$

Found, projecting 5 ins. at the corner of North-South and East-West fence lines, the 1 ins. diam. iron pipe with brass cap marked as recorded on Survey 3520 dated 1967. I mk. said cap "CS 1979", it now reads:

Reference tree marked on the above survey:

- White Oak, 6 ins. diam. Scribed "505" and "BT" in exposed faces brs. $S34^\circ 21'W$, 9.16 feet.
- An original bearing tree recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, a White Oak, 13 ins. diam. with axed out faces, brs. Record: $N50^\circ E$, 36.96 feet to estimated lower face.

I mark a new tree "CS BT":

- Black Oak, 8 ins. diam., brs. $N63^\circ W$, 12.35 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.
