

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640400

Quarter section corner common to Sections 13 and 24, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Found a 6" x 7" x 12" basalt stone with cross for the corner and the center of an Ash stool which bears South 23° East, 113.0 feet.

The plat of Donegan Orchard Tracts calls for a stone for this corner.

Ties to adjacent section corners established this as a reasonable location for said corner.

Replaced said stone with a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe set 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

From which marked the following new trees:

- A 7" White Oak scribed "CS-BT" bears South 21° East, 113.2 feet;
- An 8" Ash, in a stool of Ash, scribed "CS-BT" bears North 65½° West, 57.9 feet.
