

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 640700

Quarter corner common to Section 36, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, and Section 1, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, W.M. $V = 20^\circ$

From the following evidence, at the location described below, I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe, 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Original bearing trees recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854, found as follows:

- Black Oak, 14 ins. diam. scribed "S" in partially opened upper face, brs. Record: N55°E, 5.94 feet to scribed face.
- Black Oak, 16 ins. diam., with healed blazes, brs. S77°W, 32.17 feet to center of tree at lower blaze. Record: S77°W, 31.02 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

I mark a new tree CS BT:

- Black Oak, 7 ins. diam., brs. S53½°E, 42.44 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies about 400 feet West of location marker on 24 ins. diam. black oak, located at top of N-S ridge.
