

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700540

Quarter corner common to Section 7, Township 35 South, Range 1 West and Section 12, Township 35 South, Range 2 West.

Found original Southwest bearing tree.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 30" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T35S R1&2W
¼ 12 | 7 cor.
C.S.
1965

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 16" White Oak plainly scribed) bears South 78° West, 25.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze.

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- Scribed an 8" White Oak "CS-BT", which bears North 33¾° West, 35.1 feet to the face of the lower blaze;
- Scribed a 10" White Oak "CS-BT", which bears South 67¼° East, 24.8 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
