

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 700600

Section corner common to Sections 6 and 7, Township 35 South, Range 1 West and Sections 1 and 12, Township 35 South, Range 2 West.

Found the original Southwest bearing tree.

For corner, set a 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 32" in the ground with a 2½" bronze cap stamped:

T35S R1 & 2W

From which:

- The original bearing tree (now a 24" Black Oak plainly scribed) bears South 68° West, 19.8 feet to the face of the lower blaze;

From said pipe corner, I establish the following new witness trees:

- Scribed a 4" White Oak "CS-BT" which bears North 1¾° West, 49.0 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- Scribed a 6" White Oak "CS-BT" which bears North 34½° East, 49.6 feet to the face of the upper blaze;
- Scribed an 8" White Oak "CS-BT" which bears South 50° East, 43.2 feet to the face of the upper blaze.
