

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200500

Corner to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, Township 36 South, Range 1 East.

Found original BT to Southwest standing; also stumps of BTs to Northeast and Northwest,

From which set 6 x 10 x 14" stone for corner.

From which:

- A 6" white oak bears S.46°30'E., 17.0 feet. Scribed C.S. -BT
- Scribe a 6" white oak C.S.-BT which bears N.59°45'W., 9.5 feet.
- Scribe an 8" white oak C.S.-BT which bears N.11°E., 33.9 feet.

SECOND RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 200500

Section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M.
 $V = 20^\circ$

Found firmly set, the stone (6 x 10 x 14 ins.) placed by C. Z. Boyden in 1927. Reference: re-establishment Govt. Corners, T36S R1E, pg. 3.

I replaced said stone with a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe set 30 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

T36S R1E
S7 S8

S18 S17
Jackson County 1974

An original BT marked by Ives and Hyde in 1854,

- A White Oak, now 12 ins. diam., with healed blazes, bears record, $S72^\circ W$, 59.4 feet to center of tree.

BTs marked by C. Z. Boyden on First re-establishment are found as follows:

- A sprouted White Oak stump, 9 ins. diam. 36 ins. high, with lower face healed and scribed marks visible in upper face, bears record, $N11^\circ E$, 33.9 feet to scribed face.
- A White Oak, 9 ins. diam., with healed blazes bears record, $S46\frac{1}{2}^\circ E$, 17.0 feet to estimated face of blaze.
- A White Oak, 10 ins. diam., with healed blaze, bears record, $N59\frac{3}{4}^\circ W$, 9.5 feet to estimated face of blaze.

I mound stones around corner, deposit found stone alongside as a memorial, and marked the following tree C.S. BT:

- A White Oak, 11 ins. diam., bears $N31^\circ E$, 52.0 feet to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on fence line, 18 feet East of intersection of North and East-West bearing fence lines.
