

FIRST RE-ESTABLISHMENT

GCDB 240200

Quarter corner common to Sections 29 and 32, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, WM V=21°

From the following evidence and at the location described below, I set a 1 x 36 ins. G.I. pipe 24 ins. in the ground with a 2½ ins. bronze disc marked:

Original BTs recorded by Ives and Hyde in 1854 found as follows:

- The rotted stump remains of S.W. BT, bears record, S61°W, 29.04 feet to estimated face.
- A White Oak, 21 ins. diam., containing chain notch, scribed "4" and partial "s" in blazed face on South side of said tree, bears record, N72°W, 13.86 feet to scribed face. (center of tree bears N68°W)

I mound stones around corner, marked the following trees C.S. BT and take measurements to center of trees at lower blaze:

- A White Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears N32°E, 65.3 feet.
- A White Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S46°W, 49.6 feet.

Corner lies 5.5 feet North of East-West fence line.
